

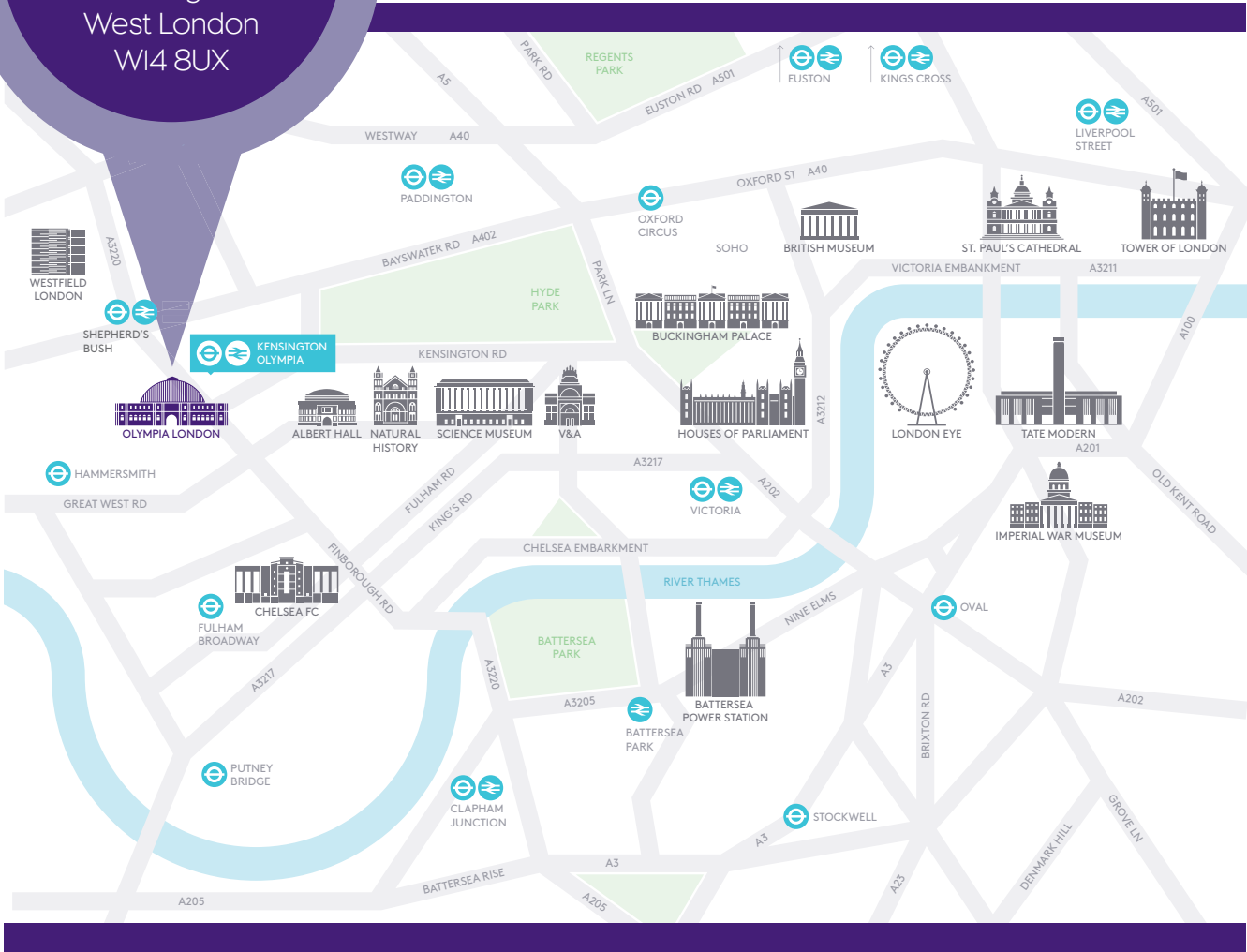
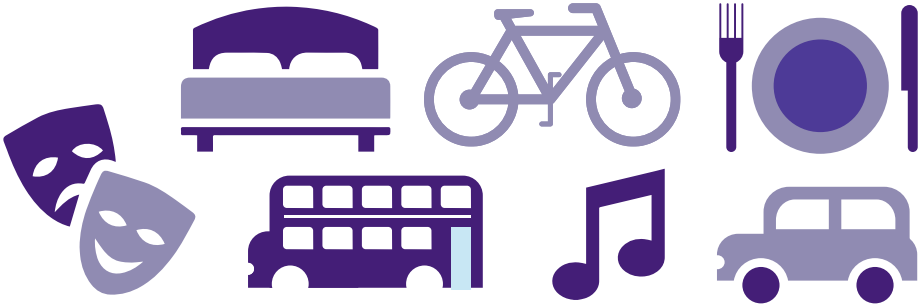
# THE IJL TRAVEL AND HOTEL GUIDE

# GETTING TO OLYMPIA

## TRAIN/TUBE/BUS

Olympia London is the only venue in London with a dedicated rail station - Kensington (Olympia). It's served by the London Overground and National Rail networks. A further five Underground lines are connected; only a short walk away.



### OVERGROUND



Kensington (Olympia) is on the London Overground network. It's one stop from Shepherd's Bush (Central line) or West Brompton (District line) and 3 stops from Clapham Junction Station.

### CENTRAL LINE



Change at Shepherd's Bush for a 2 minute Overground train to Kensington (Olympia).

### PICCADILLY LINE



Hammersmith Station is a 15 minute walk away.

### HAMMERSMITH & CITY LINE



Hammersmith Station is a 5 minute bus ride or 15 minute walk away.

### CIRCLE LINE



Hammersmith Station is a 5 minute bus ride or 15 minute walk away. High Street Kensington is a 4 minute bus ride or 12 minute walk away.

### DISTRICT LINE



Change at West Brompton for a 2 minute Overground train to Kensington (Olympia). Alternatively West Kensington is an 8 minute walk away, and High Street Kensington is a 4 minute bus ride or 12 minute walk away.

- Marylebone to Olympia:** 33 mins
- Liverpool Street to Olympia:** 36 mins

### Dedicated bus service from Earls Court to Olympia

We are delighted Transport for London will be providing a Special Event Bus Service between Earls Court Tube Station (Warwick Road) and Olympia on Monday 4th and Tuesday 5th September 2017.

There will also be a special train shuttle service from High Street Kensington to Earls Court and back on Sunday the 3rd September. Take the special event bus service

from stop C on Warwick Road. Buses leave at 00, 15, 30 and 4 minutes past each hour (first bus 0800, last bus at 1900). Please note that the bus will not run on Sunday 3rd September. Please ensure you have a valid travel pass.

\*buses are subject to change and availability

**27** runs from Chalk Farm to Turnham Green (south) and Turnham Green to Chalk Farm (north). This bus runs 24 hours a day.



**09** runs from Aldwych to Hammersmith (south) and Hammersmith to Aldwych (north). There is also a night bus route - N9

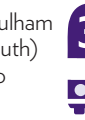


**49** runs from White City to Clapham Junction (south) and Clapham Junction to White City (north).



**10** runs from Kings Cross to Hammersmith (south) and Hammersmith to Kings Cross (north). There is also a night bus route - N10 - that extends to Richmond (south).

**391** runs from Fulham to Richmond (south) and Richmond to Fulham (north).



**28** runs from Kensal Rise to Wandsworth (south) and Wandsworth to Kensal Rise (north). There is also a night bus route - N28 that extends to Camden Town (north).

# OYSTER AND CONTACTLESS )))

It is cheaper and easier to use an Oyster Card or contactless to travel around London on the bus, tube, DLR, London Overground and most National Rail services. An Oyster Card is a plastic card which you add pre-paid credit.

Please be aware that you can no longer use cash on buses in London – Oyster Cards or contactless cards **MUST** be used.



We recommend adding an initial balance of £20 onto your Oyster Card if you are attending all three days at IJL. You can add more credit during your time in London by going to any tube station, travel information centre or Oyster ticket stop.

TFL offers a visitor Oyster Card which can be bought for £3 from Transport for London (visitorshop.tfl.gov.uk). This can be bought prior to travelling to London and posted to you.

If your bank card has a contactless symbol then you can use it as contactless payment to travel on the Bus, Tube, DLR, London Overground, TFL Rail and most National Rail services in London.

#### DID YOU KNOW?

If you use contactless to pay as you go and you make multiple journeys in a day or week, your fares will be capped. This means the amount that you pay is limited, and could be cheaper than buying a Travelcard.
